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2 The Board directs the administration to identify migratory students in the district, as required by
3 law, and to develop written administrative procedures for ensuring that migrant students receive
4 services for which they are eligible. In developing and implementing a program to address the
5 needs of migratory students the district will:¹

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- 7 1. Identify migratory students and assess the educational and related health and social needs
- 8 of each student.
- 9 2. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs,
- 10 special education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling
- 11 programs, elective classes, fine arts classes, etc.
- 12 3. Provide migratory children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment
- 13 standards that all students are expected to meet.
- 14 4. To the extent feasible, provide advocacy and outreach programs to migratory students
- 15 and their families and professional development for district staff.
- 16 5. Provide parents an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.

18 If a migrant student is identified by the district, the director of schools or designee will notify the
19 Migrant Education Department and request assistance if needed.
